"TOO FAR TO TRAVEL BY BICYCLE."

Don't bike the **whole** way... bike to the closest transit stop. CTTransit's buses accommodate bicycles, as do Shoreline East and MetroNorth trains.

"DRIVING ALONE TAKES LESS TIME."

The average speed of traffic in the city is 11 mph. You can bike faster than that. Be safe on a bike! Follow the **same rules** as cars, be visible, ride defensively, and wear a helmet.

Don't use transit, carpool, bike, or walk every day. Do it when you can. Try it **one day a week**.

"NEED MY CAR IN CASE OF EMERGENCIES."

If you carpool or use transit, you get a free taxi ride home in case of an emergency. It's called "**Guaranteed Ride Home**," (otherwise, pay for a taxi home yourself.) Emergencies are rare. Expensive parking happens every day.

"NEED CAR FOR ERRANDS OR APPOINTMENTS"

With a Zipcar membership, you have 32 cars. That's better than the 1 car you normally have, **and** you don't pay for parking. Get your department a membership and pay for business trips with a P-Card.
